Australian Sports Medal Nominees

As mentioned in last months Vetrun the nominees of the WAVACs Australian Sports Medal submission will have their resumes printed here for all to see. This month it is

Brian Foley

Tasmanian Athletics: Member in three athletics clubs in Tasmania in the 60's. Captain of the University Club and President for several years. Member of the organising committee for Hobart competitions, and 1970 Inter University Championships

Canadian Athletics: Competed in New Brunswick and Quebec from 1971 to 1977. President of rugby club competing in cross-country season.

WA Little Athletics: Board member of Melville Little Athletics Centre in the WA Association, from 1981-1987. President of the Centre for two years. Melville had 10 clubs with a combined membership of 300 athletes. Coach (and life member) of

the Attadale Little Athletics Club for 3 years.

WA Marathon Club: Member since 1980, assisting with organisation of the Perth Marathon annually.

WA Veterans Athletic Club: Member of the club for 19 years and committee member for 13 years. President of the Club for five years and vice President or Secretary for six years.

Achievements:

Prepared development plan for club with emphasis on publicity and competition safety and legal responsibilities.

Cross country team captain for 5 years and Association delegate for longer. The team won the B Grade competition on three occasions and was first in the open men's competition in 1999.

Organised the committee which ran the very successful Australian Championships in 1996

Australian Association of Veterans Athletics Clubs. The Association was formed as a legal entity in 1989, and I have been a Board member since then, and I am the longest serving member, and the Secretary for the past four years.

WA Masters Games. Member of the organising committee for the athletics competition during the 1991 Masters Games.

Athletic Association WA, AthleticA. An official for the Saturday Interclub competition for the past 7 years (Athletics Australia B grade level). Start Marshall or Starter for the past five Perth Grand Prix competitions. Coordinator of officials for AthleticA.

Coker Park Regional Athletics.

Member of the organising committee which installed lighting at the track and ran a Friday night regional competition for two years.

Disabled Athletics. Official for the WA disabled athletics competitions for two years and official at the 2000 Australian Disabled Championships in Canberra.

Para-olympics. Track official at the 2000 Para-Olympics, Sydney in October.
